## Woodland management

A fifth company – Cumbria Woodland – has been approached to provide a quotation for producing a woodland management plan. (see agenda)

### Damage to bus shelter on Hall Gate Lane

The front window of the bus shelter has been smashed. This has been reported to the police and to Lancashire County Council. It is believed that this was done at the same time as the demolition of the Preesall boundary sign, flower bed and water hydrant sign.

### Issues on Hall Gate Lane car park

The lengthsman has reported an increase in the amount of litter on the car park, with commercial waste being placed in the litter bin and large numbers of nitrous oxide canisters left strewn across the car park.
