Councillors **resolved** to adjourn the meeting to allow non-councillors to speak.

A member of the public spoke regarding the issues she was experiencing at Bowses Hill. The council explained that it was waiting for the planning application relating to this area to be validated.

Councillors **resolved** to reconvene the meeting on the conclusion of public participation.

Location: Land rear of Trevelyan 19 Stricklands Lane Stalmine Lancashire

74(16) Reports from outside bodies/councils

75(17) Clerk's report

Planning enforcement

The Freedom of Information request submitted to Wyre Council on 29 July requesting information on planning enforcement action within the parish has now been answered. A copy of the documentation is included in the councillors' pack of documents.

Footpath signage

The plantsman has started placing the posts and will continue doing this, weather permitting. A request has been made for bridleway signs. An additional 'decal' indicating the Wyre Way will also be needed as the lane by The Heads that forms part of the Wyre Way is not a designated public footpath, therefore a normal fingerpost cannot be placed there.

Dog fouling

This remains a problem throughout the parish. The issue of people actually picking up dog waste and then throwing it into fields and hedges is also a problem.

Irresponsible dog owners

A number of complaints have been received regarding dogs being allowed to run free on private land and chase wildlife unchecked by their owner.

Fly tipping

Two instances of fly tipping have been reported to Wyre Council this month.
