When you contact us

The information you provide (personal information such as name, address, email address, phone number, organisation) will be processed and stored to enable us to contact you and respond to your correspondence, provide information and/or access our facilities and services. Your personal information will not be shared or provided to any other third party.

The Council's Right to Process Information

Information Security

Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council has a duty to ensure the security of personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technical measures and appropriate policies. Copies of these policies can be requested.

We will keep your data only for the purpose it was collected for and only for as long as is necessary, after which it will be deleted. (You many request the deletion of your data held by Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council at any time).

Children

We will not process any data relating to a child (under 13) without the express parental/guardian consent of the child concerned.

Access to Information

You have the right to request access to the information we have on you. You can do this by contacting our Parish Clerk.

Information Correction

If you believe that the information, we have about you is incorrect, you may contact us so that we can update it and keep your data accurate. Please contact the Town Clerk.

Information Deletion

If you wish Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council to delete the information about you please contact the Parish Clerk to request this.

Right to Object

If you believe that your data is not being processed for the purpose it has been collected for, you may object, please contact the Parish Clerk to object.

Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling

Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council does not use any form of automated decision making or the profiling of individual personal data.

Complaints
